



## Herriman High School Concurrent Enrollment Courses 2019-2020



- Concurrent Enrollment is college-level coursework given to motivated high school students with a desire to get an early start on their career path. With successful completion of each course, students will receive **both high school AND college credit.**
- All Concurrent Enrollment courses require admission to SLCC and/or Snow College. Courses listed are through SLCC unless otherwise noted.
- Students will pay a one-time admissions fee (\$30.00 at Snow and \$40.00 at SLCC), and tuition will be due to the applicable college at \$5.00 per credit hour. For example, tuition for a 3 credit hour course will be \$15.00.
- Textbooks and lab fees may apply, and vary for each course.
- Grades will be given at semester end for Semester courses and year-end for Yearlong courses. Grades will also be recorded on the student's permanent college transcript.
- Strict attendance policies apply. Poor attendance will affect the student's grade. **See each course syllabus for grading and attendance policy.**
