- **95% attendance at school-or no more than 8 single-by period absences in a year** (activity and school excused absences are excluded)
- **Respect by arriving to class on time, receiving no more than 5 tardies per year** (this total represents all tardies in all classes each year)
- **Respect for school and teacher expectations- No discipline referrals during 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades** - Have your assigned Vice Principal sign this form, verifying your good behavior
- **Completion of 30 hours of school service through any Herriman High organized activity-** See backside of this application for service log to complete
- **Completion of 30 hours of community service through any community service organization-** (service to family and friends is excluded) See backside of this application for service log to complete

To complete your application, please obtain and submit the following:

- **Two letters of recommendation- one of the letters must be from a teacher at Herriman High School**
- **Please attach an Attendance record with absences and tardies for each year highlighted-** See the backside of this application to write attendance totals for each year.
- **Please attach a transcript - submit application with required documentation and signatures to the Counseling Center by March 31, 2022.**

Please use the log on the back of this application to list service activities and total hours. Teacher and organization signatures must be obtained to verify the service hours.

It is your responsibility to obtain the appropriate signatures for verification. Applications will not be considered if there are not dependable signatures.
